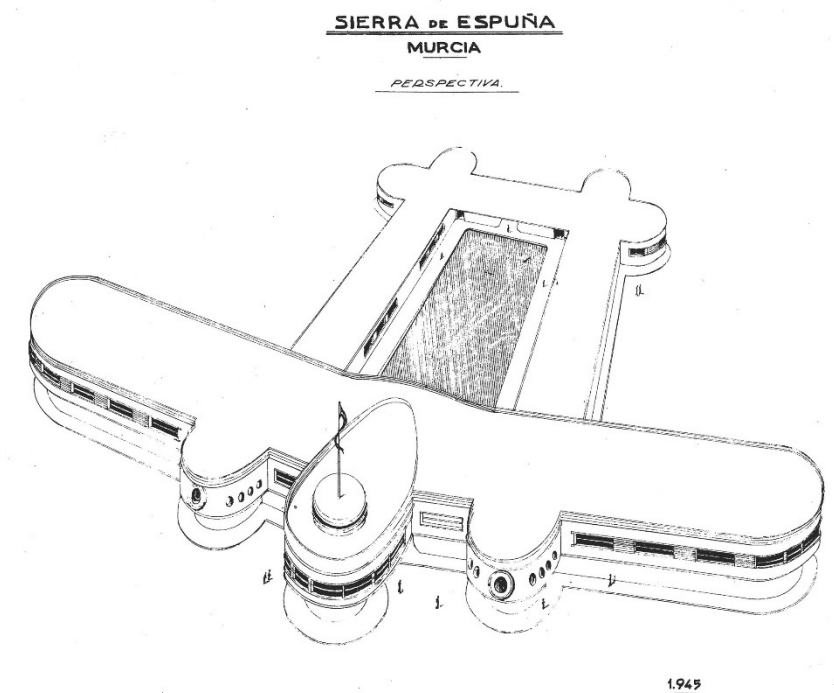

Its destination was going to be a rest residence for the Air Force and the most remarkable characteristic was its shape, because they wanted to lift an airplane in the middle of the mountain.

What has transcended to the present day has been the footprint of some of the building's walls, a water tank located in what would be the nose of the plane, the swimming pool pit and a nondescript and abandoned construction that was inserted at the beginning of the 80s to offer a restoration service.
