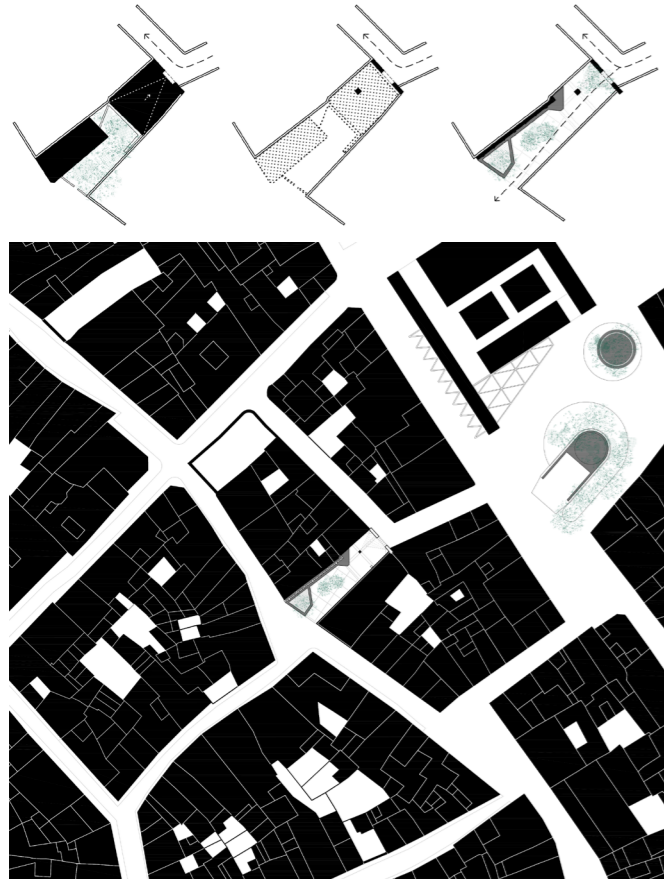

This new space improves pedestrian connectivity in the city's old town. By expropriating a dilapidated dwelling and a non-conforming building, two neighborhoods are connected: the old call and a more active commercial area, but with the intention of converting it into a place of relaxation.

The city of Inca maintains a physiognomy that is repeated throughout the island: streets with barely any vegetation and courtyards/orchards in the interiors of blocks protected from the harsh climate in winter and summer.

As many elements of the old construction as possible are maintained to enhance the interior character of this new public space. The sandstone pillars, traces of walls dating from different periods, are consolidated. The new plaza is bordered by a temporary wall toward the southeast municipal lot pending construction.

The elements incorporated emphasize the idea of historical memory and the ambiguity between the street and the interior courtyard. Vegetation that is linked to the city and the territory is planted.



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
